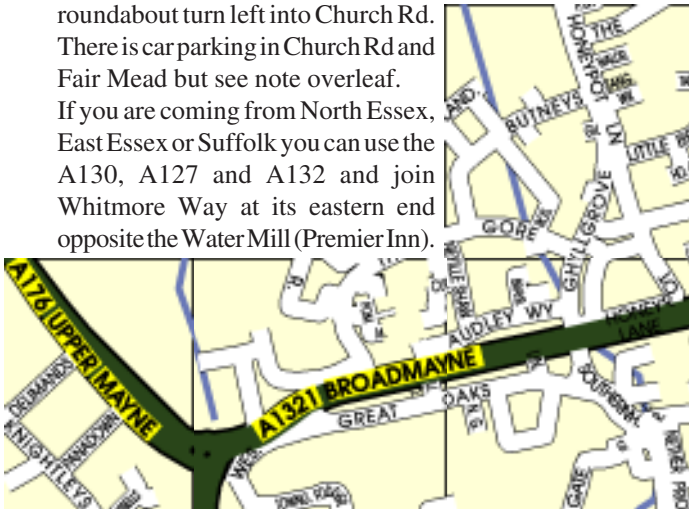
The Big One



How to get to The Willows - SS14 2EX

Basildon can be reached by A127 (from A12 or M25) or A13 (from East London or Dartford river crossing M25). Use the A176 from the A13 or A127. At Basildon Town Centre take the A1321 and turn left into Ghyllgrove at the 4th set of traffic lights. Take the first right into Whitmore Way. At 2nd roundabout turn left into Church Rd. There is car parking in Church Rd and Fair Mead but see note overleaf.

If you are coming from North Essex, East Essex or Suffolk you can use the A130, A127 and A132 and join Whitmore Way at its eastern end opposite the Water Mill (Premier Inn).



By rail Basildon is on the Fenchurch St. to Southend line. Use the No 5 Bus from the bus station to Church Rd. You need to arrive in Basildon by 9.15 to give you time to catch the bus.

SECTIONS

The Congress will be divided into six sections as listed below. All competitors will play in all six rounds. As far as it is possible, people with equal scores will be paired against each other according to the official rules for Swiss Tournaments.

All ages are taken at 31.8.13.

E.g. The **Under 6** is for competitors who were aged under 6 on 31.8.13.

Under 18 for competitors who were aged under 18 on 31.8.13. This is the upper age limit for Junior Competitors. The **Under 18** is run within the **Basildon Open Rapidplay Championship**.

Players may enter for the section for which they are qualified or in any higher age group if preferred.

Parents Room

A room will be set aside for adults as only competitors and officials are allowed in the playing hall. There will also be an area for analysis.

Rate of Play

In all sections players will have thirty minutes to complete all their moves. This ensures that all games are finished in one hour. Players who have not used clocks before will receive instruction in their use before the first round commences.

The organisers reserve the right to combine two age groups into one section if, in their opinion, numbers are insufficient for a worthwhile competition.

London Junior Chess Championships

To qualify for the London Junior, competitors in the Under 8 must gain at least 4 points out of their 6 games.

In Under 10 and Under 12 a score of 3.5 or 4 points qualifies for the Minor and 4.5 or more for the Major.

The U6 section is not a London qualifier.
